Under sections 52 and 53 of the Local Electoral Act 2001, I give notice that on Saturday 13 October 2007 the following elections will be held under the single transferable voting electoral system by postal vote:

Nominations of candidates must be in the hands of the electoral officer or one of the constituent territorial authority electoral officers or electoral officials at one of the following addresses not later than 12 noon Friday 24 August 2007:

Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 GST inclusive (payable by cash or cheque) together with a Conflict of Interest statement.

A candidate may submit a candidate profile statement with their nomination paper for inclusion with the voting documents being sent to electors. An attachment to the nomination paper outlines rules and procedures governing candidate profile statements.

Following closure of the rolls, the electoral officer of each constituent territorial authority may, on application of any person who is or claims to be entitled to be enrolled or any other person or otherwise, make any necessary corrections to the names, addresses, occupations, abbreviations, or marks appearing in the electoral rolls.
