

NON-NEW ZEALAND RESIDENTS - CHARGING FOR SERVICES DELIVERED BY BOPDHB

POLICY STATEMENT

It is Bay of Plenty District Health Board's (BOPDHB) policy that patients who do not meet the eligibility criteria in accordance with the 2011 Direction of the Minister of Health Relating to Eligibility for Publicly funded Healthcare and Disability Services in New Zealand will be charged for all healthcare and disability services that they are not eligible to receive free.

PURPOSE

To ensure that BOPDHB is financially compensated for all services delivered to ineligible patients who do not meet the eligibility criteria set out in the 2011 Eligibility Direction to receive publicly funded healthcare in New Zealand.

EXCLUSIONS

There are no exclusions.
