POLICY STATEMENT

It is Bay of Plenty District Health Board's (BOPDHB) aim that patients, where appropriate, may refuse blood products.

PURPOSE

This policy was developed to assist clinical staff in establishing acceptable medical management when a patient refuses transfusion of blood products.

EXCLUSIONS

Transfusion of blood products to minors in life threatening situations
